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GLOBAL LEARNING FOR MIND AND HEART 2016-2019

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Art Lesson Plan

Theme: Art

Class: 24 (intermediate to upper-intermediate)

Time: 45 min.

Objectives: to raise awareness among students about what art and modern art means; to improve their reading, speaking, critical thinking and cooperation skills.

Materials: Handouts, projector, course book Voices4 Macmillan

Information sources: Internet, Kahoot

Procedure:

1. Students work in groups of 3 and think of definition about art. They have to tell what art means to them. Then the leader of the group reads and writes basic points of their definition on the board.
2. Teacher using the projector shows students two paintings one as an example of modern art and the other of traditional art. Students have to point the differences between modern and traditional art.
3. Teacher shows students pictures of an installation called "Another Place" by Antoni Gormley. Students give adjectives which describe the piece of art or their feelings about it.
4. Students read the text (an email) about a work of art. After reading they have to change words in bold into their synonyms from the box.
5. Students divide words into categories (nouns, verbs, adjectives) and make sentences using them to give their opinion/description of a piece of art.
6. Four students get a name of one piece of art. They look for it in the Internet. They have to write their opinions about it. Then working in group they share their opinions

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and ask each other questions about it. Like in ex 3 p.158 (What kind of art is it?, What do you like/dislike about it?)

Additional task: Students write an email to a friend about an exhibition and opinion about one piece of art they really like.
